COVID-19 Update; **Holiday Safety Guidance**

The Town of Mars Hill continues to operate under local and statewide state of emergency proclamations. All Town facilities are open, but residents are encouraged to continue utilizing our drop boxes, telephone, and mail to make payments. Consider getting tested for COVID-19 3 to 4 days prior to travel or attending family gatherings.



Limit your holiday travel and limit physical contact with people who do not live in your household



Do not host or attend a gathering if you've been exposed to COVID-19 or have symptoms



Seat people who live together at their own table and keep tables at least 6 feet apart from one another.



Higher risk guests should consider attending events virtually.




Use single-use options or identify one person to serve food, so that multiple people are not handling


